# Demography panel set to examine growth rate disparities, infiltration

**NEW DELHI:** The demography mission announced by the Prime Minister on August 15 will likely include key ministers, to address key issues related to demographics, including illegal immigration and the disparities between the growth rates of population across India, which threaten to cause a federal rupture.

Senior government officials familiar with the matter said that while the main focus of the mission will be to combat infiltration, it will also address issues such as extensive migration, especially from states such as Uttar Pradesh, Bihar, Odisha and West Bengal to western and southern states. It will also look into ways to ensure the southern states are not penalised politically or financially for managing to get their population growth rates to desired levels — even as more populous and poor states such as Bihar and Uttar Pradesh have not.

On August 15, Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced in his Independence Day speech delivered from the ramparts of the Red Fort that his government would set up a high-powered mission to deal with demographic changes triggered by infiltration. He maintained that no country can afford to give away its land to intruders and pointed out how infiltration in border states can compromise

security and development.

Describing it as a "soch-samjhi saazish (well-planned conspiracy)" to change the demography of the country, Modi said, "Today, I want to tell you about a challenge. A new crisis is being created. And these intruders are snatching away employment opportunities of our youth."

Ahead of the West Bengal and Assam election — two states affected by illegal immigration — the issue became a key plank for the BJP that projects itself as

a nationalist party. From the revamped Citizenship Act to the NRC, illegal immigration has become one of the key political planks of the BJP.

A year ago, presenting the FY24-25 budget, finance minister Nirmala Sitharaman separately announced a key panel to address population growth issues. There are indications that all these issues will come under one mission.

According to a second functionary, internal migration and the feeling of the southern states that they are being penalised for their effective population control policies are key issues that will be addressed.

Politically, the southern states are worried that delimitation, which will happen after the 2027 Census, will see their proportionate representation in the Lok Sabha shrink and that of underperforming states (from the population control perspective) such as Uttar Pra-

adesh, Bihar and West Bengal increase. They have also raised issues about their share of compensation from revenues not being proportionate to their contributions — pointing out that they are being penalised for effective population control policies.

According to the Union Budget of FY25-26, Tamil Nadu received ₹29,456 crore in the state-wise distribution of net proceeds of taxes in FY23-24. In the same year, Tamil Nadu contributed ₹1,27,067.17 crore as tax collection. Similarly, Maharashtra generated ₹7,61,716.30 crore of tax revenue, but received ₹45,602 crores.

Meanwhile, Bihar collected ₹6,693 crore and received ₹2,607 crore from the Centre.


